Russian company orders Spanish freezers

SPANISH refrigeration company Tucal is finishing an order for a Russian shipowner to follow a recent installation in a processing factory just outside of Moscow.

Soledad Mariño of Tucal says it is too early to reveal the identity of the Russian shipowner, but the fish processing factory is owned by a company called Marina.

She tells *FNI*: "We supplied to them one compact plate freezer, with the refrigeration equipment attached.

"Because everything was pre-assembled and tested in our facilities, we built not only the freezers, but also the refrigeration equipment.

"Thanks to this, our technician was able to install the equipment on-site

and give instructions to the workers of the factory in only two days!

"This was a big advantage, as the cost to install the freezer was very low, even for sending our worker from Spain."

The company has also recently upgraded its factory by installing a welding robot that will speed up production.
